3. Your qualifications for the specific position in which you are seeking election and the particular skill sets you bring to the position and to the CANP.
4. From your understanding of the CANP strategic plan, describe your priority area(s) in which you would want to move CANP forward during your tenure as a Board member
5. What do you believe your most important contribution as a Board member would be?
6. What do you consider to be the major issues facing CANP now and in the future? As a member of the CANP Board, how would you address these issues?

The Nominating Committee will evaluate the candidates based on established criteria, and select the best qualified nominees for the slate. The slate will include a maximum of two candidates for each Officer (President, President-elect, VP of Corporate Affairs, VP of Finance, Speaker) and two candidates for the Director (Chair) positions. The slate of candidates for the Officers will be presented to CANP's House of Delegates for election. The slate of candidates for the Director positions will be presented to CANP's President and Board of Directors for appointment.

*Each candidate will be contacted after the Nominating Committee's review and those who are to appear on the ballot will be asked to complete a 'consent to serve' form (if it hasn't already been completed). **Once accepted for the ballot, some or all of the questionnaire responses may be used as candidate information appearing with the ballot.***
